The Memorial Honour Roll is meant to honor industry personal that had a major impact on the livestock and livestock marketing business on a National or Provincial level and have passed away.

To be considered for this award nominees must have had a highly respected reputation in the livestock business, an impeccable level of integrity and been publicly recognized as a leader, innovator and strong promoter of price discovery through public auction of livestock.

Inductees entering the Memorial Honour Roll will be industry people that helped make a positive difference in the livestock market sector provincially and / or nationally. Their ideas may have influenced how the livestock marketing industry conducts business today.

Some inductees may not be well know across Canada, but where an integral part of the livestock marketing sector within their Province. Nominees may have been Market Owners, Market Operators, Market Employees, Order Buyers, Auctioneers and Industry Partners.

Each Provincial Association may nominate one person per year and that nominee will be placed on the Honour Roll and given recognition at the LMAC awards banquet. If a Province feels strongly that a second candidate for any given year should be considered, the LMAC Hall of Fame Committee will review the nomination and make a decision based on merit.

Please forward your nominees to your Provincial Associations and they in turn will make the official recommendation on behalf of your Association to LMAC.
